

Joining Health Services to Improve Care

A proposal to join health services together is being explored to improve service delivery and access to care for local communities — while ensuring it continues to be close to home.

Consultation is taking place with staff and the community to gain feedback on the proposal before any final decision is made.

Nathalia District Hospital, Cobram District Health and Numurkah District Health Service, will seek approval from the Minister for Health to combine their operations under one new management entity, pending the outcome of consultation.

The existing facilities will remain in place, in their current locations. Current services will be maintained and enhanced. There will be no reduction in services or funding in relation to this proposal.

Staff are valued. There will be no reduction in staff as a result of this proposal. Existing staff will all transition to the new entity and remain in their existing place of employment.
